

WCSV Winter Internship Program

October 1, 2015-January 29, 2016



Internship Description:

WCSV's Winter Internship Program is a great opportunity to gain skills and knowledge in the treatment of sick and injured wildlife found in the Silicon Valley. WCSV is recruiting 8-10 winter interns who will work 12 hours per week from October 1st-January 29th. We will begin accepting cover letters and resumes on July 1st-September 4th.

The purpose of this internship is to assist with animal husbandry tasks, help oversee the release of patients that arrived to our hospital in the spring, as well as gain hands on experience caring for critical juvenile and adult patients that are suffering debilitating injuries and illnesses. In addition you will be assisting staff with winter projects, hospital organization, class write-ups, teaching classes, enclosure cleaning and enrichment and preparing for the 2016 busy season. Though the internship is unpaid the experience is priceless.

Requirements:

This unpaid internship requires a minimum commitment of 12 hours per week between October 1, 2015-January 29, 2016.
